(*NB: Australian Bush Poetry is defined as having good rhyme & metre, written about Australia, Australians and/or the Australian way of life).

1. Entries in all sections will be taken from nominated poems on a 'first in first served' basis. Running sheets for the order of an individual's appearance in each section will be displayed in the Crookwell Services Club.

3. **Performance:** Time Limit **8 mins** (incl. preamble)
4. **Deductions:** Ten (10) points shall be deducted in all cases for reading of poems in all open classes.
5. Five (5) points shall be deducted (from the aggregate of points for that poem) for every fifteen (15) seconds or part thereof over the set time limit.
6. Performers exhibiting loss of memory and forgetting their lines will be heavily penalised.
7. **Offensive material** (foul or explicit) will not be tolerated and will be marked down accordingly by the adjudicators. Remember, it is a 'Family' audience.
8. Winners will be announced on Sat 19th of November at the Crookwell Services Club after the conclusion of the last performance section. An Awards Ceremony for all sections (including written) will then be held.
9. For results to be sent after the competition date please enclose a **SSAE**.
10. The judge's decision will be final & no correspondence will be entered into.
